ACADEMIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission requires a natural science bachelor's degree from a suitable major, or a Social Science bachelor's degree with a natural science focus.

The following bachelor's degree programmes give direct access to the master's degree programme in International Food Quality and Health:

- Molecular Biology with focus on nutrition (AU)
- Chemical Engineering and Food Technology (BEng) (AU)
- Food Science (UCPH/DTU)

The following bachelor's degrees can also give admission: Nutrition and Health, Biology, Chemistry, Food Engineering, Food Technology and Agriculture, Food and Environment. The bachelor's degree programmes must at least include a basic course in statistics and biochemistry.

According to national legislation in China, Chinese citizens cannot apply for admission to International Food Quality and Health through a Danish university. Instead, Chinese Citizens must apply for admission through University of Chinese Academy of Sciences.

Selection Criteria

In evaluating qualified applicants, the admissions committee assesses each applicant based on the following criteria:

1. Academic background (75%)
2. Other relevant experiences (25%)

Academic background:

This criterion includes average mark of a BSc degree and the average mark of relevant courses weighted after the study load (ECTS credits)

Other relevant experiences:

Relevant work experience, BSc projects, laboratory projects etc.

The assessment is based on the supplied documented information and can, thus, not include marks/grades obtained after application deadline.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

English language skills equivalent to an 'English B level' in Denmark are required and can be documented as listed below. Graduates from a Danish "Gymnasium" have at least an English level B by default.

- IELTS: Minimum score of 6.5
- TOEFL with a minimum score of:
577 Points in the paper-based test *or*
233 Points in the computer-based test *or*
90 Points in the internet-based test
- Cambridge ESOL examinations
Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) or First Certificate with grade A as a minimum. Applicants must upload their **Confirmation of Entry** stating **candidate ID number** and **candidate secret number**, which are not stated on the test result itself.
- CEFR validated English language course
C1 level

Applicants exempted from submitting an English test are:

- "Native speakers" with a qualifying exam taught in English (including applicants with a qualifying exam from either USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Great Britain, Scotland, or Ireland taught in English).
- Applicants holding either a Danish/Nordic/Duborg/[International Baccalaureate \(from the IB diploma programme\)](#)/European Baccalaureate (from the "ScholaEuropaea") diploma with English language proficiency equivalent to [English level B in Denmark](#).
- Applicants with an English language bachelor's and/or master's degree from USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Great Britain, Scotland or Ireland. It must be documented that the teaching language was English.

By submitting your application, you agree on that you are applying for a full degree Master's Programme (120 ECTS) AND you must be in China throughout the entire study period.
