You can start your application even if you are conditionally admitted. The ST1 application form consists of two parts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> AU has completed part 1 of the form. You must fill in part 2 and submit the application.
Payment of tuition fee In early April you will receive an invoice for your tuition fee. Once we have received payment, you will receive your Student residence permit application form (ST1).		Biometrics recording Within 2 weeks of submitting your application, you must have your biometrics (facial photo and fingerprints) recorded. Please be aware of waiting times and schedule your biometrics appointment in advance. ST 1 processing time Your ST1 will be processed by the national agency 'SIRI' within two months. Please note that your application will not be processed until you have met all admission requirements and SIRI has received all necessary information and documentation from you and Aarhus University.
