You can start your application even if you are conditionally admitted.</p> <p>The ST1 application form consists of two parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> AU has completed part 1 of the form. You must fill in part 2 and submit the application. <p>Biometrics recording Within 2 weeks of submitting your application, you must have your biometrics (facial photo and fingerprints) recorded. Please be aware of waiting times and schedule your biometrics appointment in advance.</p> <p>ST 1 processing time Your ST1 will be processed by the national agency 'SIRI' within two months.
